<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Undertake a thorough Risk Assessment, identifying risks and protective measures, using all available government guidance relating to Covid 19. • Prepare and maintain the school site in-line with the Risk Assessment. • Ensure that the school site is kept clean, with regular, stringent cleaning procedures in place • Adhere to the social distancing rules set out by the government as much as we feasibly can. • Organise the staff and children into 'bubbles' • Organise the school building and school day to reduce any possible contact between the 'bubbles'. • Provide a high quality curriculum that supports the health, wellbeing and education of the children, both in school and virtually • Ensure that there is a Designated Safeguarding Lead or Deputy available at all times to support children, staff and parents. • Inform parents if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' show symptoms of COVID-19 • Work closely with Public Health England and the LA should a breakout occur 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow all altered routines, including bringing/ collecting their child strictly at the correct arrival and departure times and from the correct places. • Maintain social distancing and good hand hygiene when on the school site • Support the school in ensuring the behaviour policy and all other policies are followed to keep everyone safe. • Ensure that your child is wearing clean school uniform each day (suitable for outdoor learning) with shoes they can fasten themselves. • Keep your child at home if they, or any member of the family, are showing any signs or symptoms of illness. • Get your child tested if they show any signs or symptoms of Covid 19 and inform the school of the results. • Agree to collect your child immediately should they be showing signs or symptoms of illness. • Inform school immediately of any changes to emergency contact details. <p><i>Please refer to the Parental Handbook for further details and explanations.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Come in and out of school sensibly through the new entrance/exit at the correct time. • Sanitise or wash your hands immediately when you arrive. • Follow all school instructions about cleaning, hand washing and hand sanitising. • Stay in your own 'bubble' at all times. This includes in the classroom, around school and outside on the playground. • Tell an adult if you feel unwell. • Follow social distancing rules as much as possible— stay 2 metres from each other. <p><i>I promise I will:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Follow the school rules and behaviour policy. • Listen to the adults in school and follow instructions • Behave safely • Only use the equipment that the school has provided (and not bring in anything from home). • Try hard with all of the learning, whether at home or in school. • Stay a safe distance from others when you can
