Nursery rhymes

Nursery rhymes are a lovely part of our day in EYFS and the children really enjoy them.

You can do many different activities linked to nursery rhymes, I have listed some below and I am sure you have a lot of lovely ideas as well. Please feel free to share these ideas with your class teacher as we would love to see them. eyfs@sandbach-pri.cheshire.sch.uk

- Sing the songs with your child.
- listen out for rhyming words in the songs.
- talk about what has happened in the rhyme.
- use musical instruments to play along with the nursery rhymes.
 Do you need to be playing loudly or quietly?
- can you sing the song in different types of voices e.g. a grumpy voice, a high voice, a sad voice, a happy voice?
- Play guess the nursery rhyme game. When you child is familiar with the nursery rhymes give clues for your next song e.g. "this song is about a clock and a mouse what could it be?" then your child can guess its hickory dickory dock.
- You could act the nursery rhymes out.
- You could make lolly stick puppets and make a puppet show of your rhymes.
- Your child could draw their favourite nursery rhymes and older children could have a go (with support) at writing one of the words in the title of the rhyme.
- You could make your own spiders for Incey wincey spider.
- You can talk about the world around you linked to the songs
 e.g. I hear thunder, you can talk about the thunder and rain.
 You could make a rainy-day picture to go with this.
